

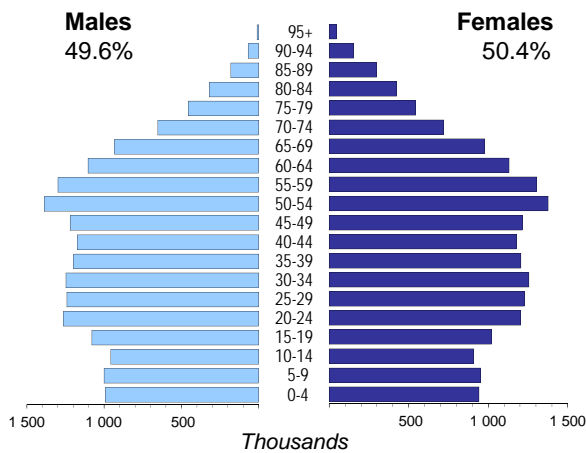

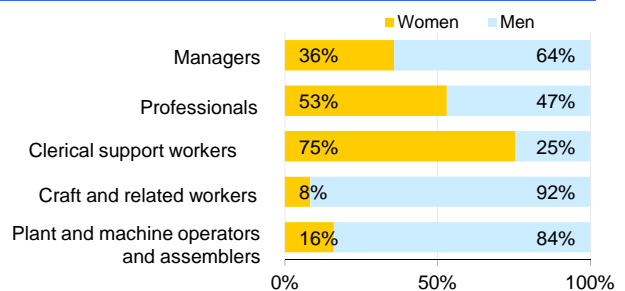
Population by age, 2015



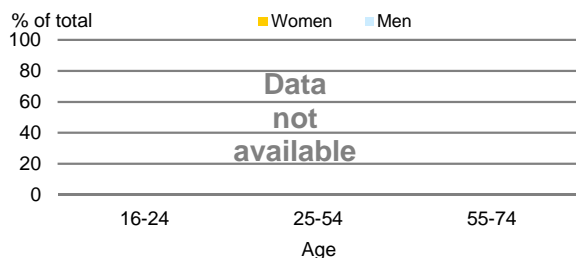

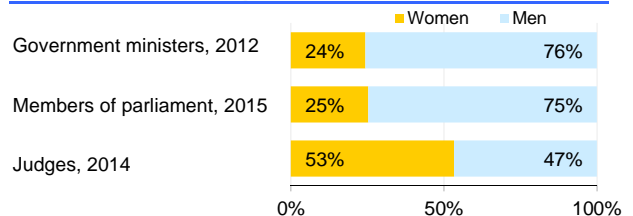
Women and men in selected occupation groups, 2013



Computer use by age and sex



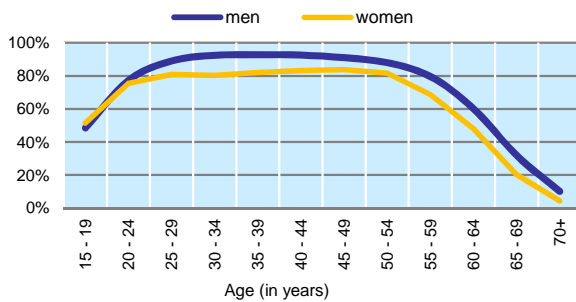

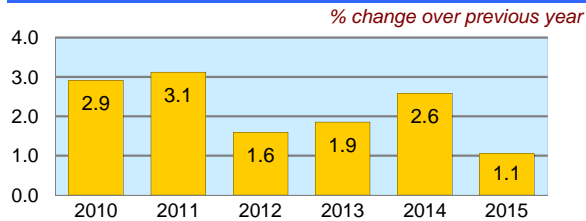

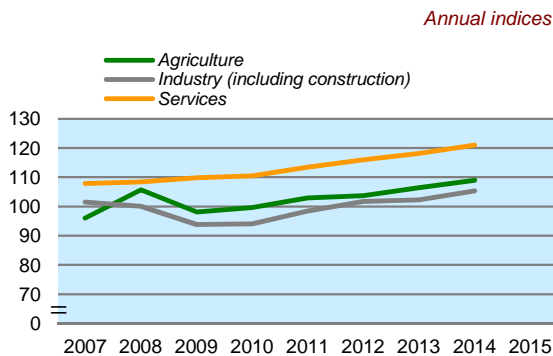

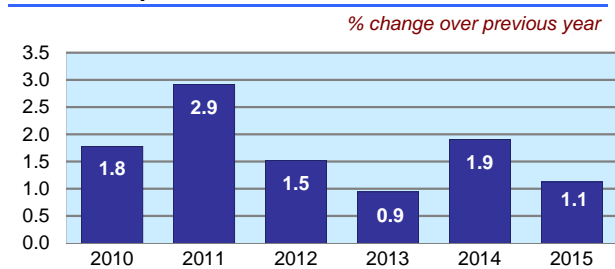

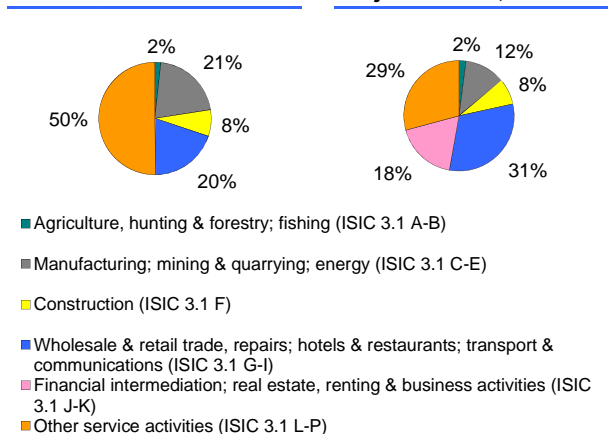

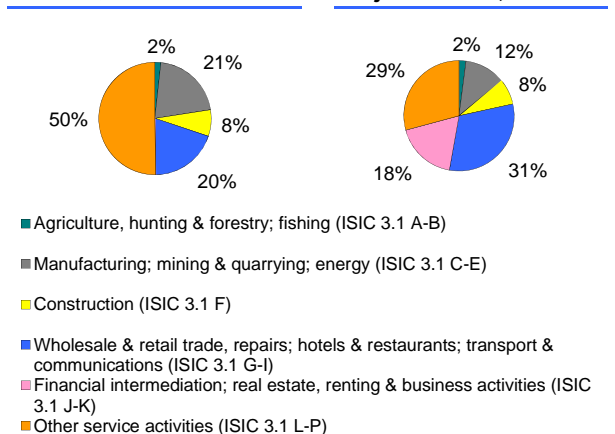
Consumer price index
