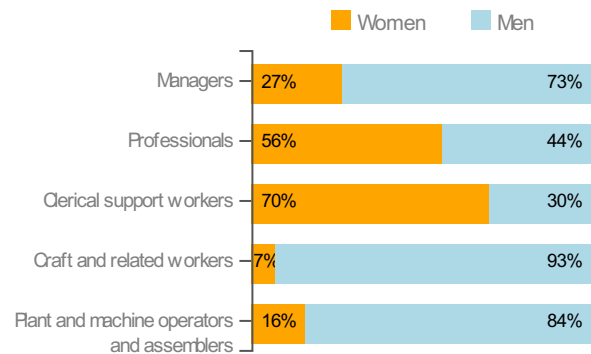

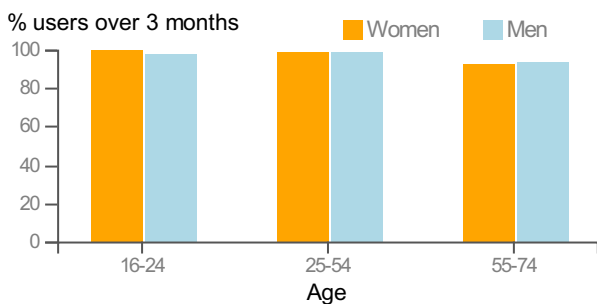

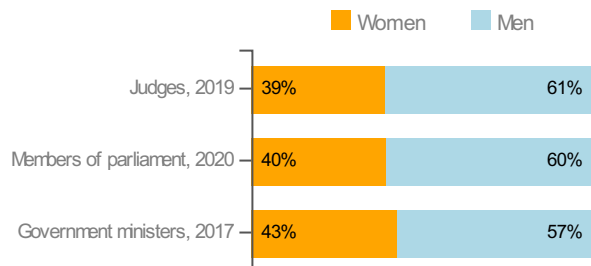
Women and men in selected occupation groups, 2019



Internet use by age and sex, 2019

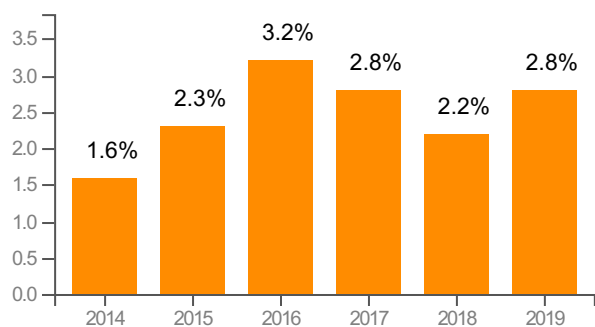

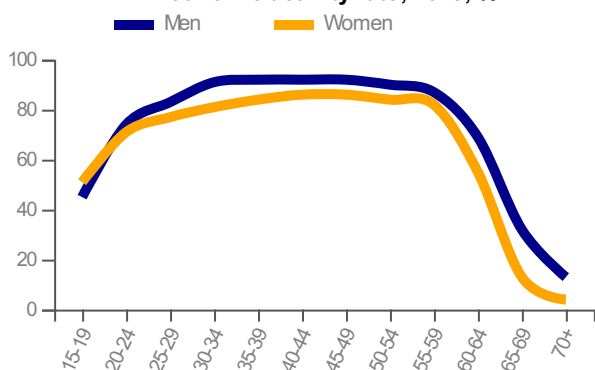

Real GDP growth rate



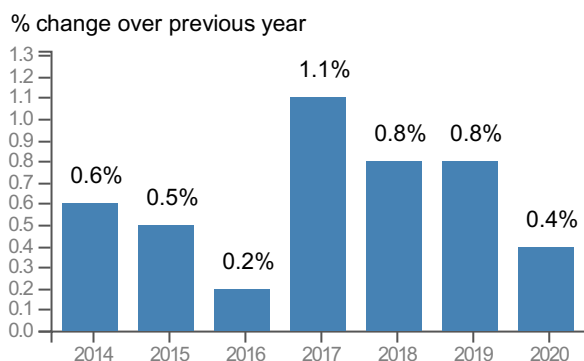
Economic activity rate, 2019, %

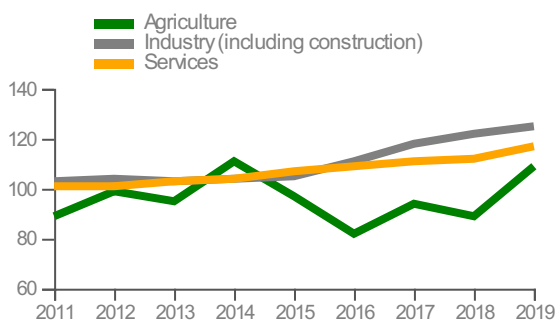

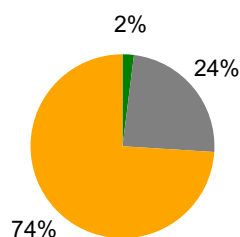

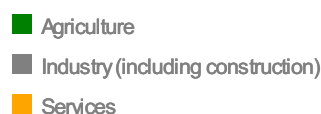
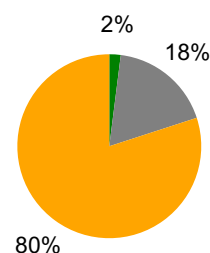
GDP in agriculture, industry, services (2010 = 100)
